






2015 Works - Civil

- Runway: repair failed areas, leaving at least 6000'X100' available at all times
- Runway: first lift of asphalt on northern 2/3
- Apron 1 Extension: base and final lift of asphalt
- Taxiway A & G: base and final lift of asphalt
- Taxiway B: excavate, backfill, base and asphalt
- Airfield Lighting Replacement


























Figure 25 : Réseau de sillons de polygones de toundra les plus apparents pour la période de 2006, cartographiés à l'aide de l'image satellitaire QuickBird.




Figure 14: Étapes de formation d'un coin de glace (Lachenbruch, 1962)































Phase (1) June 1 to July 6




























Phase (2) – July 7 to July 21


















Phase (3) July 21 – August 6
