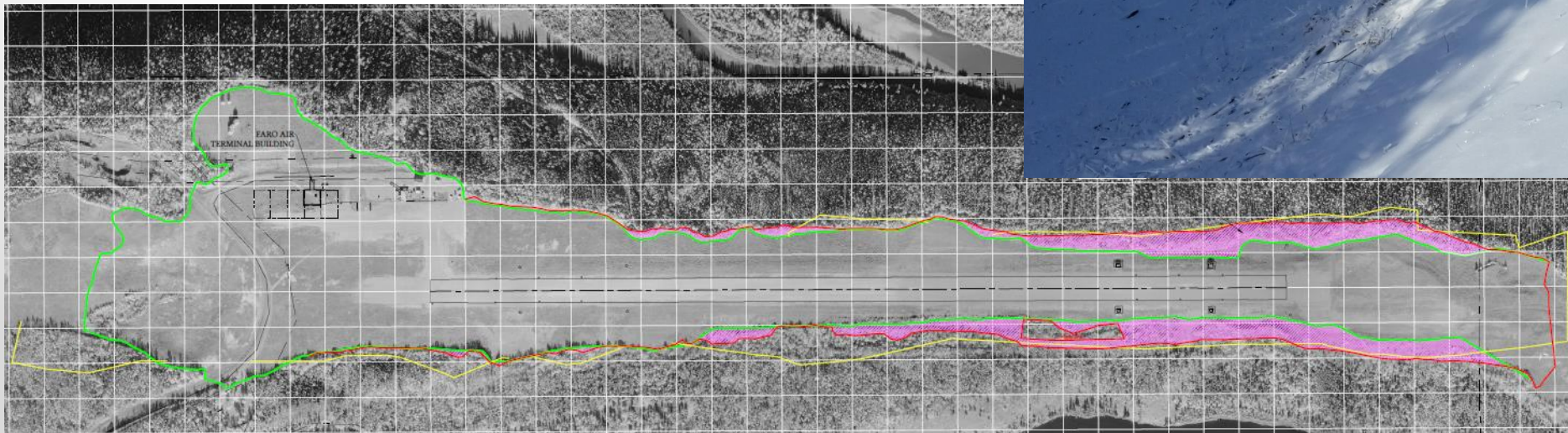

Whitehorse – Pavement Patching and Apron Rehab

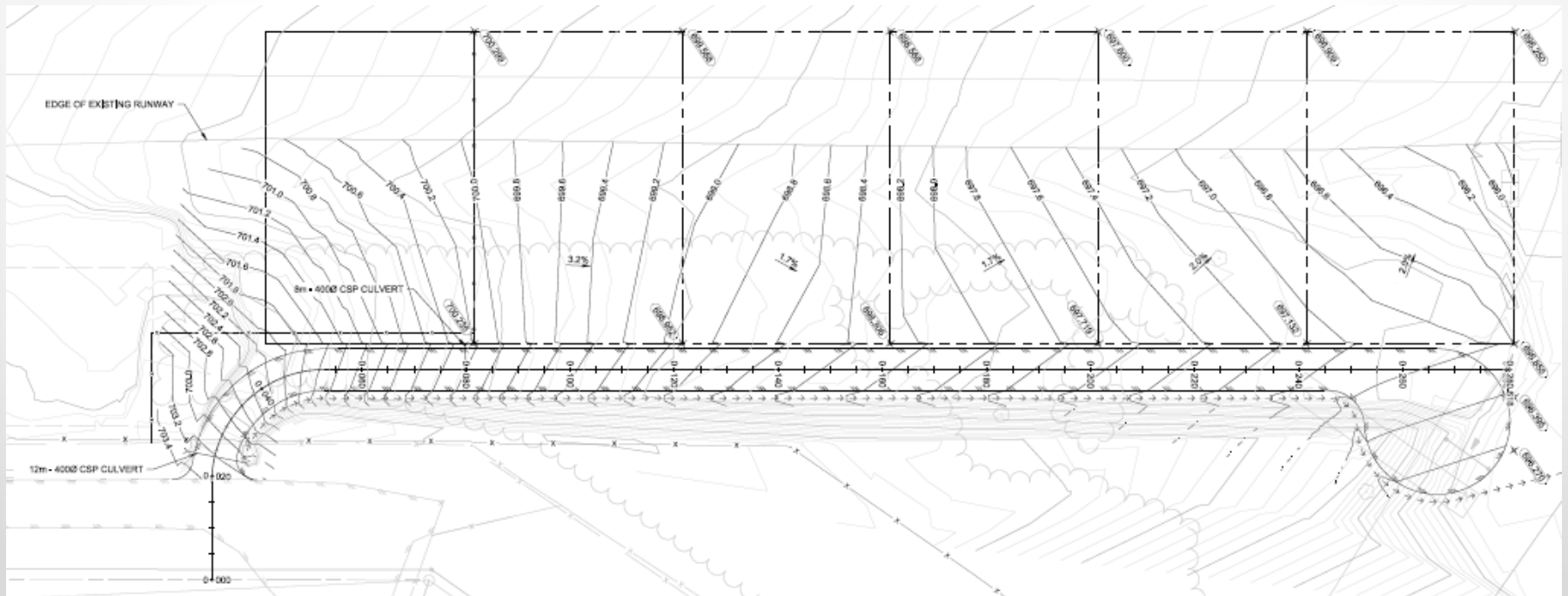
- Main Runway Patching Cracks

# WHAT WE WISH FOR IN THE FUTURE

An expanded Airports Capital Assistance Program

- Ties into 2014 NATA Resolution: TC create a Northern ACAP
- Broaden eligibility e.g. all certified airports
- Change 1,000 passenger threshold to include charter passengers
- Expand the funding pot
